Solemn Liturgy of Good Friday begins at 1:00 p.m., Adoration of the Cross and Holy Communion, followed by Stations of the Cross in the main Church. No evening devotions.

HOLY SATURDAY

Vespers 5:30 p.m.

Confessions: 9:15 p.m. – 10:15 p.m.

10:30 P.M. Solemn Easter Vigil Ceremonies followed by the Mass of the Resurrection.

All who attend Easter Vigil Ceremonies and Mass satisfy their Easter Sunday obligation; however, Communion may be received only once, either at midnight Mass or the Easter Sunday Morning Mass.
